Reuse Autumn Styria - Events



Grand opening at an Environment - "Kirtag" (traditional fair) in St. Michael

- 43 exhibitors and more than 500 participants

Followed by 13 different events-set ups in the **Styrian regions**





Reuse Autumn Styria - Events

- Open house days in several reuse companies in cooperation with WMA
- Repair Cafés at WMA in cooperation with reuse operators
- Opening of a new reuse collection corner in a waste collection center (many more to come)
- Traditional Austrian morning pint with focus on reuse at and around a local reuse shop
- Pilot-establishment of a reuse network in the district of Deutschlandberg (expansion to the whole of Styria is planned)
- Reuse pop-up store in a shopping mall



Reuse Autumn- Challanges

- Limited time for implementation
- Coordination of 10 waste management associations with 17 reuse operators involved






Online Reuse Map Styria



Public free online platform

- with up-to-date overview of regional reuse shops
- First launch in May 2021, permanent update, currently ca. 90 shops
- Increased public interest due to Reuse Autumn Styria
- Revision to meet the General Data Protection Regulation-obligations
- Expansion to include online registration option for businesses

Guide for reuse operators and start-up's

- comprising legal and organizational requirements for SMEs working in the reuse sector in Styria
- Draft version is finalized
- Current state: Review and approval by all organizations concerned, e.g. Legal department of the Region of Styria, Styrian Chamber of Commerce...
- Workshop for review with all stakeholders on 22.11.2022
 > preparation of the final version of the guideline



Guide for reuse operators and start-up's - Challenges

- Limited time for elaboration
- Post- Covid 19- lockdowns caused lack of time of external partners > delay
- General lack of personnel at many involved partners > delay
